Description:	Orton-Gillingham is a phonetically based multisensory method of reading remediation for children with dyslexia. Twenty hours of course work is conducted in the fall, prior to the start of tutoring. Course work during the academic year takes place twice a month. Practicum requires tutoring two children two days per week during the academic year. PDP's and Graduate credit available.

We are accredited by the International Multisensory Structured Language Education Council (IMSLEC). Training and tutoring are provided by the 32° Scottish Rite Masons at no cost to the students.
